



UNIVERSITY OF OREGON ENGLISH MINOR PROGRAM

{Effective Fall 1997}

The English minor consists of 24 credits of approved course work (courses to be selected from those ENG and/or WR prefix courses listed in the "Undergraduate Major Course Schedule"). The "Undergraduate Major Course Schedule" is available in the English department office, 118 PLC.

Excluded from the minor are any "Introduction to Literature" courses (ENG 104-105-106, or ENG 103 prior to Spring term, 1999, or any transfer equivalents), ENG 401, 403, or 405, or WR 121, 122 or 123.

ONLY COURSES WITH THE PREFIX ENG OR UPPER DIVISION WR MAY BE USED FOR THE MINOR.

Of the total 24 credits, a maximum of 8 credits may be taken in lower-division courses.

All upper-division course work for the minor must be taken in residency at the University of Oregon.

All course work must be passed with the grade of mid-C or better. (Grades of C- or lower, and courses graded "P" will not count for the minor.)
