The English minor consists of 24 credits of approved course work (courses to be selected from those ENG, FLR,* and/or WR prefix courses listed in the "Advising Supplement"). The "Advising Supplement" is available on the English department website and in the English department office, 118 PLC.

Restrictions:

- ❖ ONLY COURSES WITH THE PREFIX ENG, FLR*, OR UPPER DIVISION WR MAY BE USED FOR THE MINOR.
- ❖ Excluded from the minor are "Introduction to Literature" courses (ENG 104, 105, 106) and ENG 270, Introduction to Narrative Cinema Production, or any transfer equivalents of these courses. Also excluded are ENG 401, 403, 405 and WR 121, 122, and 123.
- ❖ Of the total 24 credits, a maximum of 8 credits may be taken in lower-division courses.
- ❖ Only two courses taken for this minor may be used to fulfill any other major or minor requirement.
- ❖ All upper-division course work for the minor must be taken in residency at the University of Oregon.
- ❖ All course work must be passed with the grade of mid-C or better. (Grades of C- or lower, and courses graded "P" will not count for the minor.)

* To Count FLR courses must have been listed on the annual Advising supplement.
