

London Winter 2010 Scholarship Overview

A range of scholarship support is available for those planning on participating in the London program in Winter 2010. You should investigate the different options available for supporting your studies in London. Most scholarships can be combined with other scholarships. You are thus encouraged to apply for as many scholarships as you are eligible for as the scholarship funds can really add up!

Here are some of the major sources of scholarship funding you should explore to support your studies in London.

I. UO English majors can apply for two departmental scholarships:

1. Deborah Tims Ellis Endowed Scholarship provides funding for one \$1000 on the basis of academic achievement.
2. "An English Winter" departmental scholarship provides funding for five to ten scholarships of \$500 to \$1000

II. UO students from all majors (including English majors) can apply for a range of scholarships administered of varying amounts via the UO Study Abroad office.

Scholarships applicable to the Winter London program include the Mills, AHA, and NCSA scholarships.
