

MEETING OF ADVISORY COUNCIL

and Subsequent Action of Faculty
Affecting Election of Members

February 5, 1930

The Council met in Dr. Gilbert's office mainly for the purpose of determining hold over members of the Council and to decide what vacancies there were to be filled by election. Deans Sheldon and Gilbert, Dr. Barnett and Dr. Boyer were present. Dean Carpenter and Dr. Conklin were absent from the city and unable to attend. Dean Carpenter and Dr. Boyer, having served two years, were to retire automatically. Lots were cast to determine whether Dean Sheldon or Dean Gilbert was to hold over and were won by Dr. Sheldon. Lots were cast between Dr. Barnett and Dr. Conklin resulting in the choice of Dr. Conklin to hold for another term. At the ensuing faculty meeting election resulted in the choice of Deans Carpenter and Gilbert and Drs. Barnett and Boyer to serve for the next term. The Council for 1930 is therefore as follows:

Professors Barnett
Boyer
Conklin

Since Drs. Sheldon and Conklin were chosen by lot for a second term they will retire automatically at the end of the year 1930 unless reelected to succeed themselves.
