And Action Affecting Council by Faculty

January 16, 1931


At meeting in Dean Gilbert's office prior to faculty meeting of January 16, 1931, for purpose of determining hold over members of Council, it was ascertained that Drs. Sheldon and Conklin, having served two years, should automatically retire. Lots were cast between Gilbert and Carpenter and Boyer and Barnett to determine hold over members, resulting in the choice of Dean Carpenter and Dr. Barnett for second year term. At the faculty meeting immediately succeeding, two deans were chosen, Gilbert and Rebec, and two faculty members not deans. The choices of the faculty members were Boyer and Milne. The Council for the year 1931 will therefore be:

Dean Carpenter and Professor Barnett, having served a second year, will automatically retire in December 1931.
