

Ph.D. Comprehensive/Oral Exam Application

- *The comprehensive examination is a three-part exam with questions developed by the students' comprehensive exam committee members*
- *Dates of the exam and submission of results are determined by the exam committee, but must be submitted to the HPHY office.*
- *Oral portion of the exam is usually held after the student has completed the written portions at a time and place agreed upon by the exam committee and the student, and should be no later than 14 days after the completion of the written components*.*
- *Copy of questions, graded exam, and written/oral results must be on file in HPHY Office within one week following exam.*

Application must be submitted to HPHY Office no later than Friday of first week of term exam is to be taken.
Exceptions must be agreed upon in advance by area faculty members and the student.
