**Academic Progress Rate:** A rate of .925 or below is subjected to penalties. The historical penalties include the following:

-If the APR does not improve in the first year a letter from the NCAA is sent to the University with suggestions of improvements.

-If the APR does not improve in the second year the University receives another cautionary letter.

-The third year of declining APR practice times are reduced and scholarships could be lost.

Possible factors that could lower the APR:

-Student athletes pursue a career for a professional sport.

-Points are also lost prior to the student athlete becoming eligible
