

Enrolling In An Outdoor Pursuits Program Practicum Experience

- ✓ Students assisting with any course must be enrolled for practicum.
- ✓ A Practicum experience must be approved by the course instructor.
- ✓ Enrollment may be for credit, or non-credit (ncs).
- ✓ Credit enrollments are done via Duck Call. There is no registration block on these practica. Please note that practica are listed online under PEL-Leadership.
- ✓ If you plan on enrolling for non-credit, you must complete a "permission to add" form. This form is available in the PE office (102 Esslinger) or from Michael, Dan, Jim, or your course instructor. Once you've received instructor approval, go to 102 Esslinger to enroll. Payment is required at the time of registration, in the form of cash or check. You may also bill your student account.
- ✓ All assignments are 1-credit transactions, with the exception of assistant instructorships, which are two 1-credit transactions. If you are enrolling for more than one practicum, you need to use a different CRN each time.
- ✓ Several practica are published online. Please follow these guidelines when deciding upon which practicum crn to enroll in:
 - Enroll in a \$40 practicum if you are participating in a course that includes a transportation component.
 - \$20 practica are for courses that do not include a transportation component (e.g. Rock Climbing 1, Wilderness Survival). See Dan, Jim, or Michael if you are unsure of what practicum crn to register for.

- ✓ If possible, meet with the course instructor prior to the first class session. If this is not possible, attend the first class to learn about your specific responsibilities, or contact the instructor to find out the date and time of scheduled leader meetings.
- ✓ Course descriptions and schedules are available online as pdf downloads. Download these documents from the web site, read them and bring any questions you may have to the course instructor.
- ✓ For liability and risk management reasons, enrollment in a practicum is REQUIRED BEFORE PARTICIPATION IN ANY FIELD OUTING.

Important Information About Participating In A Rock Climbing Practicum

- ✓ Enrollment in a practicum is REQUIRED BEFORE CLIMBING ON THE ROCK WALL IS PERMITTED! This applies not only to roped climbing, but to bouldering as well.
- ✓ Rock wall assistants are required to pass the basic skills test and complete the waiver/information form prior to climbing on the wall during a practicum experience. Assistants who have already completed the skills test and have a waiver form on file do not have to complete another skills test for the practicum.
